Lockesburg City Council Meeting

Tuesday, February 14, 2023

Lockesburg City Council met in regular session Tuesday, February 14, 2023 in the Council Room at City Hall. The media was notified of the meeting.

The meeting was called to order at 6:29 by Mayor Danny Ruth followed with prayer by Matt Webb and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Those in attendance were Mayor Danny Ruth, Recorder Treasurer Becky Jegstrup, Council Members Chuck Martin, Joe Stephens, Claudine Tompkins, Levi Browning, and William Roberts. Mark Schroer was absent. Also in attendance was Wastewater Supervisor Matt Webb, City Clerk JoAnna Giusti and Park Commissioner Shelia Ruth.

Guest in attendance was Lesia Stephens.

A motion was made by Stephens and seconded by Roberts to approve the minutes from the January 3rd Special Called Meeting, the January 10th regular meeting and the January 24 regular meeting. Motion passed 5/0/0.

A motion was made by Roberts and seconded by Stephens to approve the January Financial and Budget Reports. Motion passed 5/0/0.

A motion was made by Browning and seconded by Stephens to approve the Revised Budget for 2022. Motion passed 5/0/0.

Park Commissioner Shelia Ruth addressed the Council with a list of scheduled events and plans for 2023 for the Ida Margaret Coulter Stone Park. After a brief discussion of the July 4th event a motion was made by Martin and seconded by Roberts to hire Outlaws and Law Dawgs and pay \$1250. Motion passed 5/0/0. A motion was made by Roberts and seconded by Browning for the money to come from Community Relations account. Motion passed 5/0/0.

Wastewater Supervisor Webb addressed the Council to request a smoke test machine. He presented the Council with 3 units to chose from. A motion was made by Roberts and seconded by Stephens to purchase a Hurco Power Smoker Smoke Blower model 28454 and to transfer the money from Tax Account to Sewer O&M. Motion passed 5/0/0.

After a brief discussion a motion was made by Roberts and seconded by Martin to keep the Boulevard of Flags at 12 flags for \$480. Motion passed 5/0/0.

JoAnna Giusti addressed the Council about needing support for the Dell laptops as the current support will runout this year. She is to get prices for next month's meeting.

The Council also discussed animal control and abandoned structures around town. No action was taken at this time but each member took copies of ordinances related to each to review.

A motion was made by Tompkins and seconded by Roberts to approve the bills for January. Motion passed 5/0/0.

A motion was made by Tompkins and seconded by Browning to adjourn. Motion passed 5/0/0 and the meeting was adjourned at 7:54.
