AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1997-1

Ordinance # 1997-1

Disconnect Policy

Any customer wishing to discontinue their use of water, sewer, or cablevision services must first give notice to the city, otherwise the charges will continue until such notice is received. In the event of disconnection for non-payment, the reconnection fees shall be as follows:

Water           \$ 20.00 Non-refundable service charge

Sewer           \$ 20.00 Non-refundable service charge

(Note: the sewer reconnect fees would apply only in those instances when a customer had a sewer connection but no water connection.)

In order to restore services after disconnect for non-payment, the customer must pay in full. For weekend reconnect fees add 50% to the normal reconnect fee. In the event a customer is disconnected because of a mistake made by the city, the reconnect shall be forgiven and a credit of the next month's bill will be issued up to a maximum of \$ 20.00.

Checks are an acceptable payment method.

If a customer has two returned checks within any 3-month period, that customer will be required to pay her/his bill with cash or money order for the next 1 year.

Returned checks must be picked up with cash or money order and all fees paid. There is a \$ 20.00 returned check fee and a \$ 20.00 reconnection fee applied to the balance that must be paid in order to restore water/sewer services.

AMENDMENT NO. # 2

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1997-1

Tap Fees:

Water and Sewer Tap Fees Shall be Cost plus 10% on All New service lines.
