

ORDINANCE 1997-2 AMMENDMENT

LOUD NOISES DEFINITION

Loud Noises are prohibited. The causing of any unreasonably loud and disturbing noises of such volume or duration as to be detrimental to the life or health of any individual, or to disturb the public peace and welfare is prohibited.

Specific Noises. In addition to the disturbances set forth in Article 1, the following are specifically prohibited: the playing of any radio, stereo, music reproduction system or musical instruments in such a manner or of such volume, particularly between the hours of 10 PM and 7AM, as to disturb the peace and quiet of residents; and sustained automobile engine noises in private garages or driveways.

Barking dogs prohibited. In addition to the disturbance set forth in Articles 1 and 2, loud and frequent barking by dogs is specifically prohibited.

Fine. Any violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed two hundred dollars (\$200.00).

Geographic Area. The ordinance covers only the geographical area within the City Limits of Lockesburg.

Dog Owners in Violation. Owners will be verbally warned for the first offense. The second offense there will be a fine of \$25.00. The third offense fine is \$50.00. The fourth offense will incur a fine of \$100.00. With the fifth offense the dog will be removed from the owner's property or possession and placed in the City of Lockesburg's Animal Compound.
